The award according to Lisa Foss Olson, Recognition Committee Staff Liaison with Care Providers of Minnesota, recognizes frontline caregivers for their contributions that lead to improved quality of life for residents and create a better work environment for the housing with services/assisted living community's staff. Williams who is a Lifesprk caregiver at Oak Meadows, a senior living community, was nominated by her peers who felt her positive attitude contributes to the overall well-being of people she serves and increases team moral.

Naomi Fluck, RN, Lifesprk Director of Campus Life Care at Oak Meadows, said that she witnesses Williams's contributions on a daily basis. "At Lifesprk, we empower our employees to help spark the lives of people in the second half of life because we know it helps keep them off the roller coaster of health care crises," shared Fluck.
